The Chester County Estate Planning Council brings together attorneys, trust officers, accountants, financial planners, wealth managers, investment planners, stockbrokers, insurance agents, appraisers, realtors and nonprofit planned giving officers.

What is Estate Planning?

- Estate Planners arrange for the protection, orderly administration and disposition of a client's wealth in accordance with their wishes.
- Estate planners are especially called upon for major life events such as birth, marriage, divorce, sudden money, inheritance, business succession, incapacity and death.
- Estate planning requires expertise in state property, probate and trust laws; and tax laws—federal and state income, gift, inheritance, estate, and generation-skipping transfer tax.
- Estate planning areas include:
 - ⇒ Creating a will
 - ⇒ Setting up durable power of attorney
 - ⇒ Naming an estate executor to oversee the terms of the will
 - ⇒ Establishing a guardian for living dependents
 - ⇒ Deciding beneficiaries on plans such as life insurance, IRAs and 401(k)s
 - ⇒ Setting up trust accounts in the name of beneficiaries
 - ⇒ Philanthropy planning to arrange for estate gifts to charities.

Guidelines

The Chester County Planning Council Marc P. Riddell Scholarship awards :

- \$1,000 academic scholarships
- to West Chester University students
- entering junior or senior year
- studying business, accounting, finance or pre-law.

The CCEPC Scholarship includes complimentary CCEPC membership:
